In the month of September we:

- Answered 5,455 phone calls
- Issued 21,235 items via prescription
- 3,294 patients had an appointment of which 3,133 were seen face to face
- 1,699 referrals for further care
- Issued 250 fit notes
- Received 6,466 digital requests
- 161 patients did not attend appointments

'Movember' is an annual event involving the growing of moustaches during the month of November to raise awareness of men's health issues, such as prostate cancer, testicular cancer, and men's suicide. Our practice manger John Williams is sporting a moustache throughout November for this very worthy cause.

A growing number of men – around 10.8M globally – are facing life with a prostate cancer diagnosis. Globally, testicular cancer is the most common cancer among young men. And across the world, one man dies by suicide every minute of every day, with males accounting for 69% of all suicides.
